## **Burglary Suspect In-Custody**

**Residential Burglary Arrested** 

On October 7, 2014, Buena Park Police Detectives attempted to serve a residential burglary arrest warrant in front of an apartment complex in the 7400 block of Crescent Avenue. The suspect, Devin Curtis, a 20 year old resident of Buena Park, fled on foot evading the Police. Curtis ran up the stairs into an apartment, broke out a window, and jumped out that second story window to the rear of the apartment complex. Detectives did not initially locate Curtis.

On October 8, 2014, Detectives obtained information Curtis was possibly at a residence in Moreno Valley. After further investigation, Detectives responded to the Moreno Valley area and subsequently made a traffic stop in which Curtis was arrested. Riverside Sheriff's Deputies assisted during the arrest.

Detectives recovered stolen property in the trunk, including jewelry, a cellular phone, and an I-Pod, which were all identified as property stolen from an Anaheim residential burglary. A follow-up search of Curtis' vehicle parked at the residence in question in Moreno Valley, yielded additional stolen property, including a women's purse, which had been reported stolen from another Buena Park residential burglary in July. Detectives recovered a backpack full of stolen property in the garage, which was reported stolen from another Buena Park residential burglary in the 7400 block of Crescent Avenue on October 7<sup>th</sup>. Curtis broke into a different unoccupied apartment after he fled from Detectives the day prior. He likely stayed inside for several hours, ate and drank their food, then stole their property before going to Moreno Valley. Curtis was charged with multiple counts of residential burglaries by the Orange County District Attorney's office.
