# **Wanted for Armed Robberies**

**Buena Park PD CR# 10-17557 / 10-17562**



**Suspect #1: Male black, 5'9"-6'0", 180-190 lbs, black hoodie sweatshirt, black knit beanie with eye holes cut out and used as a mask, black jeans, white & black tennis shoes, and wearing latex gloves. Armed with a 5" silver semi-automatic hand gun.**

**Suspect #2: Male black, 6' 2"-6'3", 280-300 lbs, black hoodie sweatshirt, black mask, black jeans with a "W" type logo on rear pockets, black tennis shoes, and wearing latex gloves.**

On May 2, 2010 at approximately 10:00 PM, two suspects entered Tacos Mexico which is located at 7695 Knott Ave. in the City of Buena Park. Suspect #1 enters business and walks directly to the rear of the restaurant passing Victim#1. At the same time suspect #2 enters the business while pulling down a ski mask. Suspect #2 directs victim #1 to the back of the restaurant while holding a silver semi-automatic. Suspect #2 tells victim #1 to call the cook (victim #2) out of the kitchen. Both victims are detained at the rear of the location. Suspect #2 locates cash hidden in a locker and also removes cash from registers. Suspect #1 binds both victims' wrists behind their backs using zip ties and they are placed in restroom. Victims are able to get free and contacted police. Loss of \$550.00 cash. No suspect vehicle seen.

On May 2, 2010 at approximately 10:45 PM, two suspects entered JK Foods which is located at 8530 Commonwealth Ave. in the City of Buena Park. Suspect #1 walked to a rear office where victim #1 was. While displaying a gun suspect #1 demanded to know where the safe was. At the same time suspect #2 forced victims #2 and #3 onto the floor while he removed cash from front counter cash registers. Victims #2 and #3 were then taken to the rear office where victim #1 was. Victims #1, #2, and #3 were then forced into a rear bathroom and search for money and phones. Suspects directed victims to remain in the bathroom and fled. A short time later the victims exited the bathroom and contacted police. Loss was over \$1500.00 cash. No suspect vehicle was seen.
