FATAL TRAFFIC COLLISION INVESTIGATION Police are seeking additional witnesses

BUENA PARK, Calif. — On Saturday, August 14, 2021, at approximately 6:39 pm, officers from the Buena Park Police Department responded to Western Avenue and Auto Center Drive regarding a traffic collision involving two vehicles. Upon arrival, officers located the driver of one vehicle, who later succumbed to his injuries as a result of the collision. The passenger was transported to a local hospital in critical condition.

Thus far, the preliminary investigation indicates this was a hit-and-run incident with one outstanding suspect. The investigation shows the suspect vehicle was traveling westbound Auto Center Drive through Western Avenue on a red light striking the victim vehicle, which was traveling southbound Western Avenue on a green light. All occupants of the suspect vehicle fled on foot from the scene prior to police arrival. The suspect vehicle was left at the scene.
