INCIDENT: Attempt Homicide

LOCATION: George Bellis Park, 7171 8th Street, Buena Park

DATE/TIME: Wednesday, October 29th, 2014, 2013/1:00 a.m.

SUMMARY:

On Wednesday, October 29th, 2014, at approximately 1:00 a.m., officers were dispatched to calls of suspected gunshots heard at George Bellis Park. Arriving officers located two male adult victims who sustained gunshot wounds. They were treated at the scene by Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) personnel and transported to a local hospital. A third gunshot victim was located in the 6300 block of Knott Ave along with a fourth victim who was unharmed. The third victim was also treated on scene by OCFA personnel and transported to a local hospital. All the victims are in stable condition at this time and the wounds appear to be non-life threatening.

The suspect is described only as a male dressed in black clothing. The motive for the shooting is unknown at this time and the investigation is on-going.
