Operation of an alarm system without a permit is a misdemeanor and could result in criminal sanctions. Please respond within ten (10) days. Thank you for your cooperation and, if you need any assistance in clarifying this matter, please call (714) 562-3993.

**THE FOLLOWING IS TAKEN FROM THE ALARM ORDINANCE AND IS SUPPLIED FOR YOUR INFORMATION**

1. For at least seven (7) days this alarm has been tested with the police notification device disconnected. During that time, the alarm has been used in the normal fashion without any false alarms.
2. This intrusion/burglar alarm (if any) has an audible prealarm that sounds for at least thirty (30) seconds before transmitting a silent alarm. This does not apply to holdup/robbery alarms or unused entry point of a burglar alarm.
3. This exterior audible alarm (if any) has an automatic shut-off feature designed to cut off the sound within 15 minutes maximum.
4. You are required to notify the City of any changes in the status of this alarm such as names, phone number or type of alarm within ten (10) days.
5. This permit is valid for one year.
6. It is a misdemeanor to operate an alarm without a current, valid alarm permit.
